Sealed bids for the project entitled **Broad River Water Authority – Grassy Pond Pump Station Improvements** will be received by the **Broad River Water Authority** at **2:00 p.m.** (local time) **on Thursday, September 10, 2020** in the **Main Conference Room of the Water Treatment Plant located at 1661 Baber Road, Rutherfordton, North Carolina.** At said place and time, all Bids that have been duly received, will be publicly opened and read aloud.

THE PROJECT GENERALLY CONSISTS OF: the installation of a 3rd pump; associated piping, fittings, valves and appurtenances; an outdoor diesel engine-generator and automatic transfer switch; variable speed motor controller and associate electrical improvements; and SCADA improvements at the Grassy Pond Pump Station located in Mooresboro, NC.

Each bid shall be accompanied with a cash deposit or certified check drawn on a bank or trust company insured by the FDIC or a Bid Bond prepared on the form of Bid Bond contained in the Bidding Documents or a Surety Company’s standard form and properly executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds. The amount of the bid bond shall be equal to **five (5) percent** of the total of the bid. The bid deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful bidder fails to execute the contract or fails to provide the required bonds, as stated above, within ten (10) days after the proper notice of award of the contract.

Bidders must comply with the requirements of the State of North Carolina and be appropriately licensed as an Electrical Contractor as provided in General Statutes Chapter 87.

Bidders are encouraged to only secure project bid documents as noted above. Neither the Owner nor the Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from any source other than the Engineer and their representative plan provider, QuestCDN. Each Bidder shall be responsible for the review of all addenda for the project and shall acknowledge the addenda on the bid form.

The Broad River Water Authority has adopted a “Minority Business Participation Outreach Plan” (MBPOP). The goal of the Broad River Water Authority in adopting its Plan is for the expansion of participation by historically underutilized businesses (HUB) in construction projects as defined in GS 143-128.2 (g). Equal access and opportunity to participate in all aspects of construction projects shall be provided to HUB. It is the policy of Broad River Water Authority to award public building contracts without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age or

disabling condition. Each bidder shall make a good faith effort and shall document such efforts to utilize minority businesses and comply with the Broad River Water Authority's plan.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 as amended, which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours Standard Act, and 40 CFR 33.1016, and 40 CFR 60-4.
